Did John write the Apocalypse?

Dionysius of Alexandria, writing in the third century, disputed with some who said the author of the Apocalypse was someone other than John the disciple of Jesus. He pointed out some expressions and ideas in Revelation that also occur in John's Gospel and in his epistles, but nowhere else. The examples he cited are included in the table below, together with some others, with references added.
